Standards Council of Canada

- Federal Crown Corporation established in 1970
- Reports to Parliament through the Minister of Innovation Science and Economic Development (formerly Industry Canada)
- Mandate to:
 - *Coordinate* standardization activities in Canada (domestic and international)
 - *Accredit* Standards Development and Conformity Assessment Organizations
 - *Advise* federal and provincial/territorial (P/T) governments
 - *Support* strategic priorities of industry and governments
 - *Represent* Canada in international and regional forums

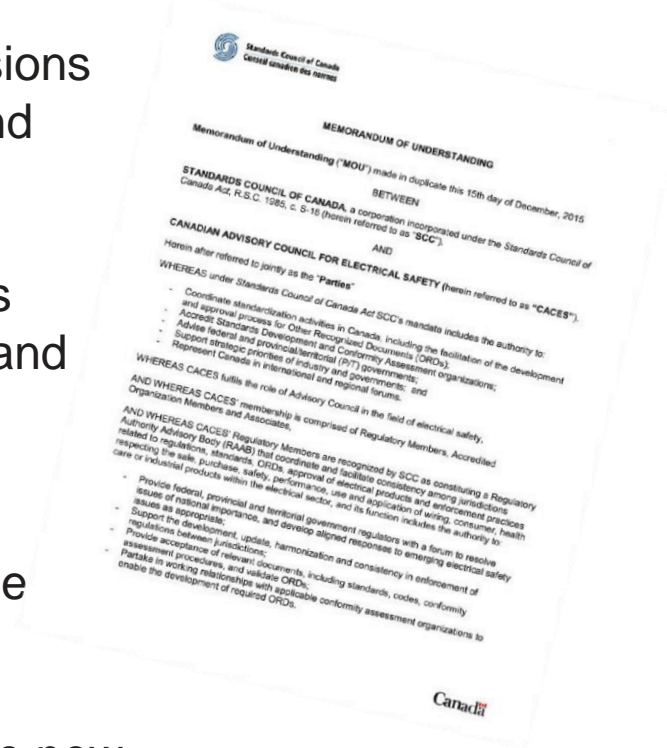

MOU with RAABs



SCC- MOUs with Regulatory Authority Advisory Bodies

- Calls for coordination, sector collaboration, and informational exchanges about activities and decisions pertaining to standards, conformity assessment and ORDs.
- Provides for roles and responsibilities for regulators in the field of standards, conformity assessment, and validation of ORDs.
- Following the signing of an MOU, SCC recognizes regulatory members of these authority bodies as the RAAB responsible for their respective sector.
- SCC will also support RAABs with implementing the new Guidelines on the Development and Maintenance of ORDs.





Work with RAABs

- **SCC-Canadian Advisory Council for Electrical Safety (CACES)** MOU signed February 10, 2016
 - As of June 2016, SCC provides Secretariat Coordination and Services to regulatory members
- SCC-Interprovincial Gas Advisory Council (**IGAC**) MOU signed November, 2016
- MOU in development with the Canadian Regulatory Council on Plumbing (**CRCP**)
- SCC attended annual meetings of **CACES**, Association of Chief Inspectors (**ACI – Boiler and Pressure Vessels**), **CRCP**, and the **Council of Canadian Fire Marshals and Fire Commissioners (CCFM&FC)**
- SCC has been invited to the Association of Provincial Chief Elevators Inspectors, (**APCEI**) Oct. 2017, AGM



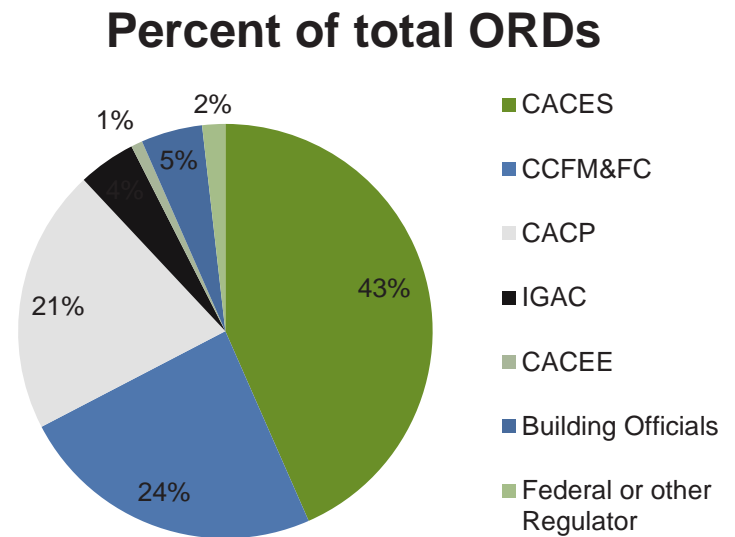
ORD Guidelines and legacy issues

- May 2016, publication of SCC's *ORD Program Overview* and the updated *Requirements and Guidelines – Product, Process and Service Certification Body Accreditation Program*
- SCC currently reviewing legacy ORDs with CBs
- Signing of MOUs with other regulatory authority bodies will expedite the resolution of legacy ORDs under their respective jurisdiction, and SCC's support to implement the new ORD guidelines
